## **JOB PURPOSE**

The post holder will respond to the unmet needs of young people in 'Anytown' via the implementation of a children and young person's social prescribing model. The Link Worker will connect children and young people into a broad range of services and interventions in their local area in a timely and effective way, led by the wants and needs of the young person themselves.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### The key responsibilities of the post holder are to:

- act as the point of contact for children and young people accessing the service arranging meetings by phone or in person as required
- · support each individual to access services or activities relevant to their needs
- coordinate the referral process from start to finish, communicating regularly with all stakeholders
- record monitoring data systematically, produce timely reports and contribute to the overall evaluation
- · keep track of each young person's engagement with the scheme and their outcomes
- attend reflective practice and/or clinical supervision, team meetings and line management meetings as required
- build strong working relationships with internal and external services in both the statutory and voluntary sectors and to promote the link worker/social prescribing model
- create and maintain referral routes into the scheme via a wide range of frontline professionals in the health, education, youth justice, social care and community development sectors
- give young people a voice, ensuring they influence operational and strategic direction of the service.
- be an active and contributing staff member, attending meetings as required and working constructively as part of a team to meet all organisational goals
- attend mandatory training and abide by all organisational policies and procedures, including Safeguarding & Child Protection, Health and Safety and Equality and Diversity
- · attend appropriate continuing professional development, training and networking events
